

Intact forest landscape destroyed or fragmented by **oil development near the town of Voyvozh**, approximately 60 km west of Troitsko-Pechorsk, in eastern Komi (Republic of Komi, Russia). Old-growth fir and spruce forests, probably

with Siberian pine (dark brownish green), which are surrounded by birch or birch and aspen forests (turquoise, gray), are disturbed and fragmented by oil infrastructure (roads, pipelines, drilling pads, etc.)
